I had to go on disability because of my health, but even though I have some artificial parts inside of me I will be out on the streets Feeding and Clothing the Homeless, but the most important part of this is Preaching to them about Jesus Christ.



I will be going into the Streets of Savannah Georgia this month to survey the Homeless situation. I know for a fact the Homeless have camps along the railroad tracks and if you are not careful you could get killed quick. Many Homeless are Outlaws and Trust Nobody. I did a small survey once before in Savannah and found some areas where they were feeding out of Trash Dumpsters.

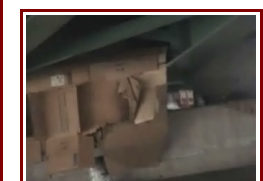
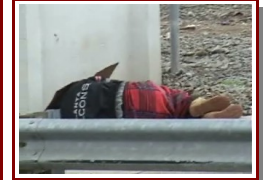
We are trying to plan ahead for next Winter. Gloves and Warm Coats, and even Rain
